Infants in the validity study achieved AIMS total scores (X±SD) of 25.4±4.9 and Bayley Motor Scale raw scores of 33.4±4.9 at 6 months of age. At 12 months of age, they attained AIMS total scores of 49.7±7.9 and Bayley Motor Scale raw scores of 58.0±5.2.

### Alberta Infant Motor Scale (AIMS) - Elon University

Alberta Infant Motor Scale (AIMS) Scores range between 0-58. Higher scores indicate more mature motor development. Recommended cut off scores for atypical development are the 10th%ile @ 4 mos of age, and 5th%ile @ 8 mos of age. Best at identifying infants with motor disabilities at 6, 9, 12 mos; use caution when interpreting AIMS scores for infant 3 mos of age or > 9 mos.

### Alberta Infant Motor Scale (AIMS) by Karen Bensley

Median (range) corrected age at assessment was 6 (2, 12) months. 12 (21%) had an AIMS score <10 th percentile and 11 (19%) had a Bayley-III motor score <85. The AIMS percentile correlated strongly with the Bayley-III motor composite score (Spearman r=0.83, p<0.001).

When a baby attends his first physical therapy session, he will most likely be evaluated using the Alberta Infant Motor Scale. This scale assesses the motor development of babies birth to eighteen months of age. It breaks down the components of infant movements, up until independent walking is achieved.

### Understanding Physical Therapy Outcome Measurements: The ...

The Alberta Infant Motor Scale (AIMS) is a norm-referenced measure of infant gross motor development. The objectives of this study were: (1) to establish the best cut-off scores on the AIMS for predictive purposes, and (2) to compare the predictive abilities of the AIMS with those of the Movement Assessment of Infants (MAI) and the Peabody Developmental Gross Motor Scale (PDGMS).

### Assessment of gross motor skills of at-risk infants ...

In case of TIMP, its validity was measured by comparing it with Alberta Infant Motor scale (AIMS) and correlation between scores on the TIMP and the AIMS was highest for TIMP tests at 90 days and AIMS testing at 6 months (r=0.67, p=0.0001) concluding that TIMP can be used clinically to identify infants likely to benefit from intervention.

The Alberta Infant Motor Scale (AIMS) is a norm-referenced assessment of motor development for infants from birth to 18 months of age. It was designed to look at motor development over time up to age 18 months and to identify motor development delays. Clinical take-home messages from this study are:

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
