Modern Approach. While at common law, the child was considered the child of no one, the modern approach is to consider the child the biological mother's child. This means that the child has a right to inherit from his or her biological mother unless there was an adoption where the mother did not remain a legal parent.

Inheritance Rights for Legitimate and Illegitimate Children

Children, or minors, don't have the full legal capacity of adults. Typically, minors aren't granted the rights of adults until they reach the age of 18, although this varies from state to state (19 in Alabama and Nebraska, 21 in Mississippi).

Modern Law Today, every state gives an illegitimate child the right to inherit from their maternal relatives. However, it is generally more difficult to establish the right to inherit from a child's unmarried father. Most states do not automatically presume that the child is the legal child of their father.

In some places, legitimation automatically occurs if the parents subsequently marry, if the mother marries someone else, or if the father publicly acknowledges and supports the child. Many statutes authorize a court declaration of the legitimacy of the child. The modern trend is strongly toward legitimation.

The legality of child pornography is explicitly addressed in 94 of the 187 Interpol member states as of 2008, according to research performed by the International Centre for Missing & Exploited Children (ICMEC) Koons Family Institute on International Law and Policy. In adoption ...first modern adoption legislation, the Adoption of Children Act, was passed in the U.S. state of Massachusetts in 1851. It required judges to determine that adoptive parents had "sufficient ability to bring up the child" and that "it is fit and proper that such adoption should take effect."

Maryland's child abuse statutes make it illegal to physically, emotionally, or sexually abuse minors. Under Maryland law, certain third parties and professionals with access to children (such as teachers and pediatricians) are required to report any knowledge or suspicion of abuse to the authorities.
