A cross stitch is an x-shaped embroidery stitch from which the name of Cross Stitch Embroidery is derived. It is easily accomplished by stitching two half stitches over each other. This stitch is the basis for all cross stitch. You will see it the most, and it is the most commonly used. This is the stitch with cross-stitch. You will base all other stitches on this first one.

Cross stitch is based on the use of a single stitch. The 'cross stitch' simply makes an 'X' on the fabric with floss and completing the first stitch requires two steps. It's easy to learn, though there are some key tips that you will want to know right from the beginning.

When stitching on Linen over 2 threads, you can make the 3/4 cross stitch with a blunt needle. Half colored boxes in our cross stitch patterns are for 3/4 cross stitches. Bring the thread from the backside of the fabric to the front in one of the corners of your long leg. Then, cross the diagonally and

make your long leg.
