At ArcGIS 10, there are two main ways to start an edit session: by clicking the Editor menu on the Editor toolbar or by right-clicking a layer in the table of contents, which automatically starts an edit session on the entire workspace containing that layer. If you use the Editor menu to start editing on a data frame that contains data from multiple workspaces, you are prompted to choose the workspace to edit.
