Not by Faith Alone: The Martin Luther Paradox. Martin Luther. Martin Luther struggled greatly with James' "not by faith alone" (Jam. 2:24). In fact, he once offered his doctor's cap to anyone who could reconcile it with Romans 3:28 and scoffed at his friend, Philip Melancthon, for attempting it. To Martin Luther, James was an epistle of straw that had "nothing of the nature of the Gospel about it."

### Not by Faith Alone: The Martin Luther Paradox

For years the Lutheran Church has used watchwords to articulate this doctrine: A sinner is justified by grace alone (sola gratia) through faith alone (sola fide) for the sake of Christ alone (solus Christus), a truth revealed to us in Scripture alone (sola Scriptura).
