The 60° filter paper funnel. Many conical filter funnels have an angle of about 60°. Folding a filter paper cone so that it beds well down into the funnel, creating a good seal when wet, makes for an efficient filtration step. Very often users will fold the paper cone with the same 60° angle.

Wet the filter paper using a small amount of the liquid that is the solvent of the mixture being filtered. After the filtrate has been collected, pass a small amount of the wash liquid through the filter paper to wash the residue. Select a Buchner funnel of appropriate size for the amount of residue you are collecting, not the amount of filtrate.
