Strategies and Models for Teachers

At the elementary level our ELD instructional model is a “pull-out” model. Students leave their classrooms and work in small groups to practice and learn language in a meaningful and supportive environment. Students receive anywhere from 90 minutes to 225 minutes of instruction, 3-5 days a week, depending upon their language proficiency levels.
