Multi-level Governance - Oxford Scholarship

Multi-level (or multilevel) governance is an approach in political science and public administration theory that originated from studies on European integration. The concept of multi-level governance was developed in the early 1990s. The theory resulted from the study of the new structures that were put in place by the EU (Maastricht Treaty) in 1992.

Multi-level governance is defined as the vertical (multiple levels) and horizontal (multiple actors) dispersion of central government authority (Bache/Flinders 2004) and refers to both, political structures and decision making processes (Schäfer 2010). While governance refers to the “growing interdependence between governments and non-governmental actors at various territorial levels” (Bache/Flinders 2004, 3) the concept of multi-level governance adds the dimension of scale.
