Open Bite Correction: Orthodontic Treatment Options. Many children have open bites during the primary and mixed dentition phase, which is when baby teeth are falling out and permanent teeth begin to grow in. Children may outgrow it once permanent teeth fully erupt unless the malocclusion formed due to genetic reasons (skeletal). For example, an open bite may self-correct if childhood habits (e.g. thumb sucking) diminish early on and the jaw and permanent teeth develop normally.

Anterior open bite is defined as the front teeth not connecting properly when the back teeth have already made contact. Between 1.5% and 11% of the population may have an open bite of some degree, depending on the country. The opposite is a posterior open bite, where the back teeth don't touch when the front teeth are closed. This kind of malocclusion isn't so common, but it can sometimes happen during treatment with braces or elastics for open bite.

Extrusion of the upper and lower incisors is a common orthodontic treatment for anterior open bites. This treatment is appropriate if the patient has an open bite with a normal skeletal pattern but may also be used in patients with vertical dysplasias who have deficient incisor display at rest and when they smile.

achieve stable treatment results.
