The vehicle is bearing SS Obergiuppenfuhrer (Lieutenant General) Reinhard Heydrich, the German Reichsprotektor of the occupied Czechoslovakian provinces of Bohemia and Moravia.

More broadly, however, Heydrich’s assassination did little to thwart the mechanics of violence, and in reprisal all the men in the Czech provinces Lidice and Lezaky were murdered en masse.
