Review of Tedlock's Time and the Highland Maya

In general terms of climate, the Maya lowland region experiences a rainy and muggy season from June to October, a relatively cool season from November to February, and a hot season from March to May. The heaviest rainfall ranges from 35-40 inches per year on the west coast of the Yucatan to 55 inches on the east coast.
