However, though Punjab has only 3.52% area under forests (ISFR, 2013)yet it supports a diversity of 1897 Angiosperms, 48 Pteridophytes, 34 Bryophytes, 948 Fungi and 397 Algae reported in the wild. Amongst faunal diversity, the state is especially rich in population of birds (428 species) and fishes (131 species).
